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Uniform Policy

1. Statement of Intent

The student dress code consists of an agreed standard and items of clothing. It includes a school uniform that Home Hill High School students wear when:

- Attending or representing their school
- Travelling to and from school
- Engaging in school activities out of school hours.

2. Code in Times of Non-Uniform

At certain times of the school year, e.g., attendance at some ceremonies, some sports carnivals and non-uniform days, the dress code applies without the requirement to wear the school uniform. On such occasions students are required to dress appropriate to the occasion and time of day, with consideration of Workplace, Health and Safety (WHS) issues.

Appropriate clothing must be worn:

- · Broad brimmed hat
- Closed in shoes must
- Shirts and dresses must have sleeves
- No inappropriate words or pictures on garments
- Dresses/skirts/shorts must be a reasonable length
- Exposure of undergarments is not permitted
- Bike shorts or leggings must not be worn with brief shirt
- Reasonable makeup
- Reasonable jewellery, i.e., maximum two earrings per ear, no chains, bracelets or rings

Shirts or dresses which expose the midriff, cleavage, or bare shoulders must not be worn.

Acceptable or reasonable dress refers to clothing or apparel that would be socially acceptable. Appropriate refers to matching the dress to the occasion e.g., sports day, school day or evening ceremony.

3. Uniform

Shirt: School approved shirt with school emblem.

Shorts: Plain, bottle green shorts. Minimum shorts length must be halfway between hip and knee. A plain bottle green skirt with inverted pleats and HH logo may be worn as an alternative.

Shoes: Preferred colour is black. For safety reasons, shoes with impervious uppers are required in some areas of the school to comply with WHS regulations.

Socks: Plain white, grey or black socks, or plain white with a green and gold band (no logos).

Sun Safe Shirt: Long sleeved sun safe shirt with school logo in the same pattern as the regular school uniform shirt.

Hats: Green and gold with school logo. Hats must be worn for all outdoor activities and may be purchased at the tuck shop via QuickCliq, EFTPOS & cash and the school office during business hours, cash only.

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Jewellery: Limited to a watch, plain gold/silver sleepers or studs or plain black spacer. A maximum of two earrings per ear is allowed. Facial piercings permitted at the discretion of the Principal and must comply with WHS regulations. Chains, bracelets, rings and anklets are not permitted, unless permission is granted in exceptional circumstances by the Principal. If an exemption on the basis of exceptional circumstance is warranted, a letter explaining the reasons a student needs to wear items of jewellery e.g., medical bracelet, needs to be supplied by the parent to the school.

Hair colour: Natural colours only.

Nails: must comply with WHS requirements.

Winter Clothing: Jumpers are bottle green with no unapproved logo or words. Black tights or trackpants with no logos or words are permitted during winter months.

Formal Uniform: Home Hill SHS has a formal uniform. The school keeps a range of these available for students to borrow for formal events.

- Charcoal grey trousers, long sleeved plain white business shirt (worn with a school tie which can be borrowed from the school), or
- Charcoal grey skirt, white short sleeved formal blouse (worn with a school tie which can be borrowed from the school)
- Black shoes are required
