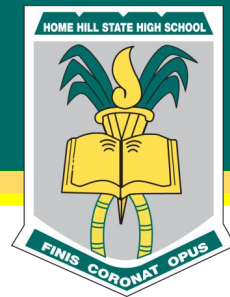

At Home Hill SHS we have computers to be used in classrooms. However, it is beneficial for a student to have access to their own personal laptop/computer, if this is possible.

Students can bring their own laptops to school for their personal use, on the understanding that they are responsible for their laptops and the school does not accept responsibility for damage or loss.

They may opt into the BYOX program. They may use their laptops in classrooms without being in the BYOX program. Opting into the BYOX program gives the student access to the internet and some resources while they are at school. There is a cost for opting into the BYOX program.

For full functionality and compatibility with the school IT infrastructure a Microsoft Windows system is recommended. There are no set minimum specifications, however we offer the following as a guideline for appropriate current specifications.

Processor – Intel Core i5 (quad core minimum) or AMD Ryzen 5 (quadcore minimum); Memory - 8GB RAM; Hard Drive –256-512GB SSD highly preferred over mechanical; Network, Wifi & Ethernet, Bluetooth. The recommended Operating System (OS) is Windows 10.
