Uniform Policy

Dress Code - Statement of Intent

The student dress code consists of an agreed standard and items of clothing. It includes a school uniform that Home Hill High School students wear when attending or representing their school, travelling to and from school, engaging in out of school activities out of school hours.

Uniform

Shirt: School approved shirt with school emblem.

Shorts: Plain, bottle green shorts. Minimum shorts length must be halfway between hip and knee. A plain bottle green skirt with inverted pleats and HH logo may be worn as an alternative.

Shoes: Preferred colour is black. For safety reasons, shoes with impervious uppers are required in some areas of the school to comply with WHS regulations.

Socks: Plain white, grey or black socks, or plain white with a green and gold band (no logos).

Sun Safe Shirt: Long sleeved sun safe shirt with school logo in the same pattern as the regular school uniform shirt.

Hats: Green and gold with school logo. Hats must be worn for all outdoor activities and may be purchased at the tuck shop.

Jewellery: Limited to a watch, plain gold/silver sleepers or studs or plain black spacer. A maximum of two earrings per ear is allowed. Facial piercings permitted at the discretion of the Principal and must comply with WHS regulations. Chains, bracelets, rings and anklets are not permitted, unless permission is granted in exceptional circumstances by the Principal. If an exemption on the basis of exceptional circumstance is warranted, a letter explaining the reasons a student needs to wear items of jewellery eg medical bracelet, needs to be supplied by the parent to the school.

Hair colour: Natural colours only.

Nails: must comply with WHS requirements.

Winter Clothing: Jumpers are bottle green with no unapproved logo or words. Black tights or trackpants with no logos or words are permitted during winter months.

Formal Uniform: Home Hill SHS has a formal uniform. The school keeps a range of these available for students to borrow for formal events. Parents may decide to purchase a formal uniform for their student but it is not expected that students have a formal uniform.

- Charcoal grey trousers, long sleeved plain white business shirt (worn with a school tie which can be borrowed from the school), or
- Charcoal grey skirt, white short sleeved formal blouse (worn with a school tie which can be borrowed from the school)
- Black shoes are required

Code in Times of Non-Uniform

At certain times of the school year students are not required to wear the school uniform. On non-uniform occasions appropriate clothing must be worn. Offensive words or symbols on clothing, and thongs are not permitted. Shirts must not show midriff or cleavage. Short or skirt length must be between mid-thigh and knee. WHS and sun safety requirements still apply for some subjects.
